This presentation will highlight the value of supporting parents using Parent Implemented Intervention (PII) in addressing the management of challenging behaviors. The Eastern Los Angeles Regional Center and Family Resource Center developed a collaboration (parent/professional), to provide additional support to parents in need of guidance and strategies to use within the home, including the use of modeling, coaching, and collaboration when implementing PII with their children. The Pandemic has highlighted the need for parents to be supported in learning how to create more structure in the home and to play an increased role in interventions. The collaboration project provides skills and knowledge to create positive change in behaviors.
